### **Floor Schedule and Procedure**

- **Suspension Bills:** Today, the House will consider several bills on the Suspension calendar. Bills considered on the Suspension calendar are debatable for 40 minutes; may not be amended; and require a two-thirds vote for passage. If a recorded vote is requested, it will be postponed.

  3. H.Res. 505 – Recognizing the innumerable contributions of the recreational boating community and the boating industry to the continuing prosperity and affluence of the United States (Rep. Klein – Transportation and Infrastructure)
  4. H.R. 2011 – To designate the Federal building and United States courthouse located at 100 East 8th Avenue in Pine Bluff, Arkansas, as the "George Howard, Jr. Federal Building and United States Courthouse" (Rep. Ross – Transportation and Infrastructure)
